Anesthesia must be metabolized (broken down) by the liver and kidneys. It is recommended that bloodwork be performed prior to anesthesia to ensure proper function of these organs. Bloodwork will not guarantee that there are no anesthetic or surgical risks; however, it provides better insight to your pets general health.

- Urea Nitrogen (BUN) – kidney function enzyme
- Glucose (GLU) – blood sugar
